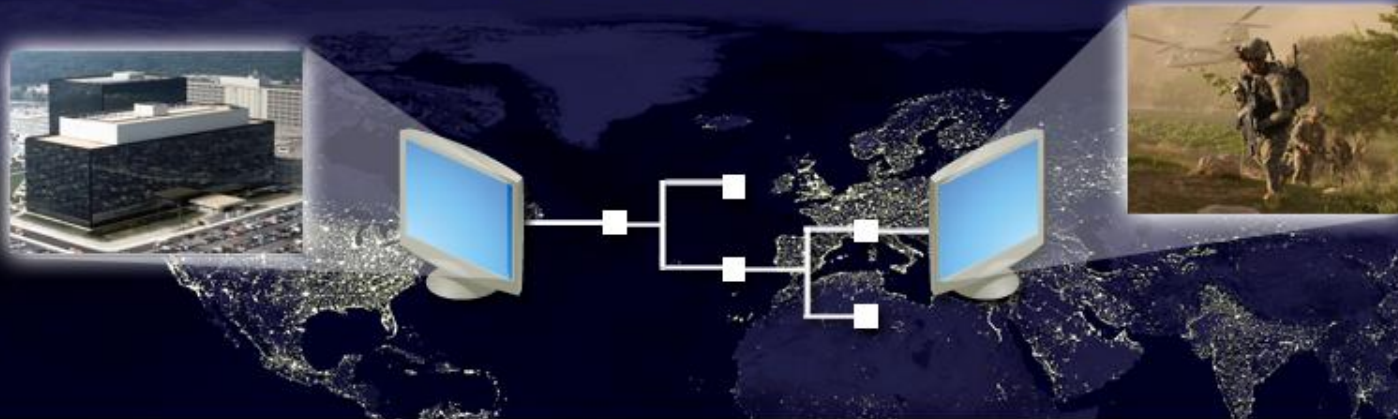
Expeditionary Operations

 - Plan, lead and support network target information

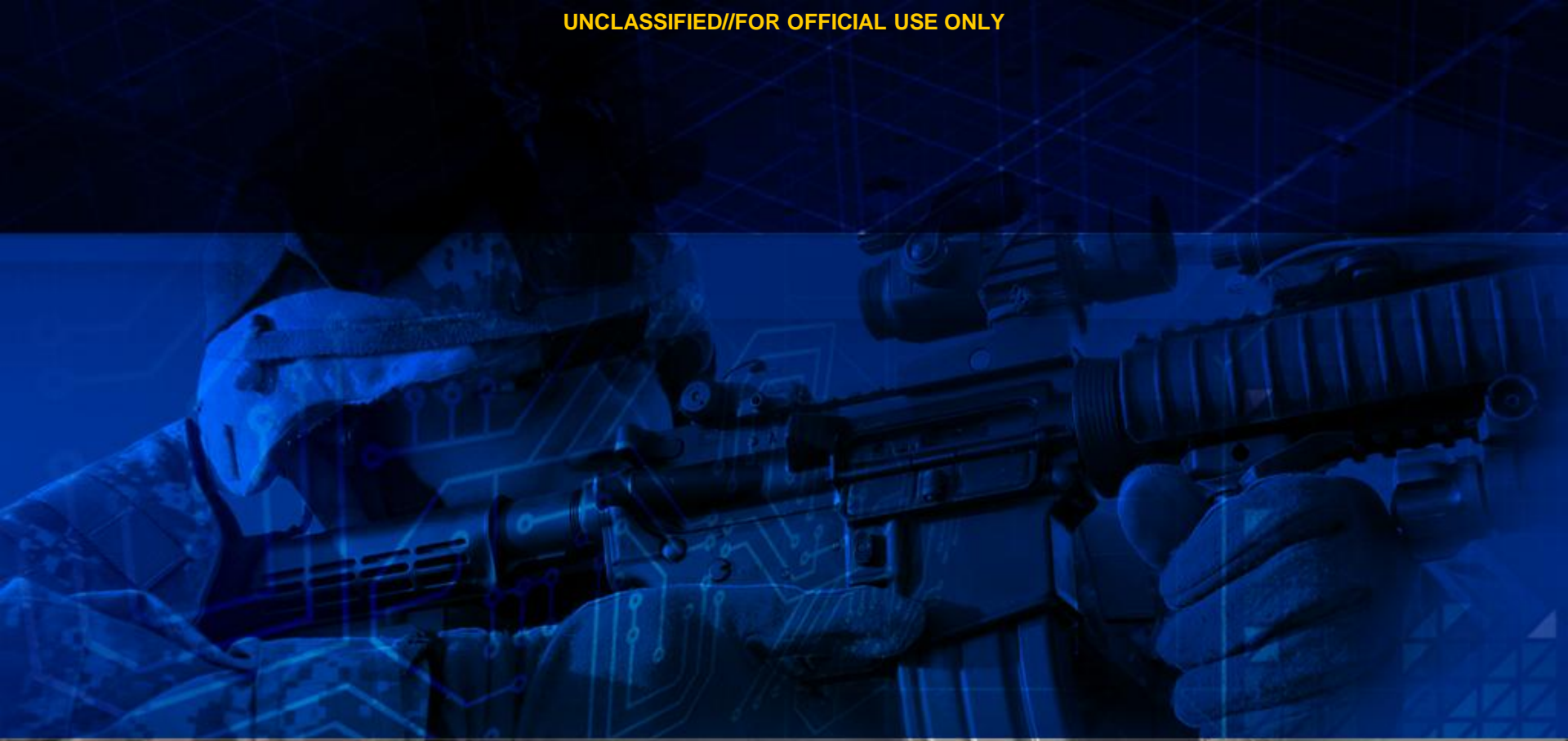
