Please see the following PIRs for Hurricane Isaac. These are questions that we need information on immediately.

PIR 2: (IR - PS 2) What are the circumstances and status of local criminal activity involving looting, price gauging, or shootings?

St. Bernard S.O. - One burglary/looting arrest involving the home of a resident who evacuated.

PIR 3: (IR - PS 3) What is the number and status of serious physical injury or fatalities as a result of the storm?

PIR 5: (IR - PS 5) What are the other significant issues that affecting public safety as a result of the storm?

PIR 6: (IR - PS 6) What is the status of curfews in effect?

- 08-29-12 1535: Town of Roseland has no power for water well. They have 6 hours of water left.
- 08-29-12 1510: Troop B Jesuit Bend area being notified to evacuate due to high water possibly overtopping the levee.
- 08-29-12 1436: I-310 Hale Boggs/Luling Bridge shut down because a ship has broken free.

- 08-29-12 1356: Amtrak services to and from New Orleans suspended
- 08-29-12 1335: Troop B was notified that no vehicle, including law enforcement, is allowed to cross the Lake Pontchartrain Causeway Bridge.
- 08-29-12 1143: Plaquemines Parish Evacuation on-going in Braithwaite due to 18 miles of over-topped levee.
- 08-29-12 1141: Plaquemines Parish Evacuation of Riverbend Nursing Home
- 08-29-12 1140: US 61 n/b and s/b at Causeway is closed due to flooding.
- 08-29-12 1022: I-10 w/b and e/b at US 51 (milepost 209) is flooded and all lanes are closed. W/B diverted to I-55 north, e/b traffic to LA 3188.
- 08-29-12 0702: St. John Parish is 80-90% without power and experiencing problems with the water supply in Laplace.
- 08-29-12 0519: St. John Parish has a report of a possible tornado/funnel cloud on US 61 near Hemlock. There are reports of a transformer and live wires arcing in the area.
- 08-29-12 0318: The Braithwaite Levee in Plaquemines Parish has been overtopped by water.
- 08-29-12 0047: New Orleans Mission remains without power and has low lighting provided by a generator. LANG is providing security. Ochsner West Bank has a failed generator and no HVAC or email access. They are running on emergency power with 5 days of fuel.
- 08-28-12 2340: Tulane Lakeside Hospital is without power and has a generator en route from Covington.

Credentialing/Re-Entry Procedures for Louisiana

Louisiana's credentialing/re-entry policy is managed at the Parish level. Individuals requesting access post landfall need to have a state and/or company identification card. Additionally, they need to have the name of the employing company, a POC for verification and a letter on company letterhead describing which facility is being supported. Individuals possessing these items will be granted access through control points.
