Functions

 - Criminal intelligence
 - Terrorism information
 - Public safety

- Public health





NCRIC Threat Analysis

NCRIC provides analysis based on:

- Special Events (e.g. Fleet Week)
- Analyst-observed threat/activity trends
- Leads or requests from private sector and law enforcement partners

Information Flow

- Information Collection and Dissemination to over 5,000 NCRIC Public Safety Members.
- Your Public Safety Agency's Bulletins and BOLO's can be sent through the <u>www.ncric.org</u> web system. E-mail your dissemination requests to <u>dutyofficer@ncric.org</u>.
- The NCRIC's Roam Secure Alert Network (RSAN)
 - Available to Your Agency to provide immediate threat/status information.
 - Capable of transmitting 18,000 text messages/minute to key NCRIC members' portable electronic devices and e-mail
