- **Functions**

- Compile, integrate, analyze, and disseminate information of various types
 - Criminal intelligence
 - Terrorism information
 - Public safety
 - Law enforcement Alerts
 - Public health
 - Critical Infrastructure
- Support efforts to anticipate, identify and prevent criminal or terrorist activity

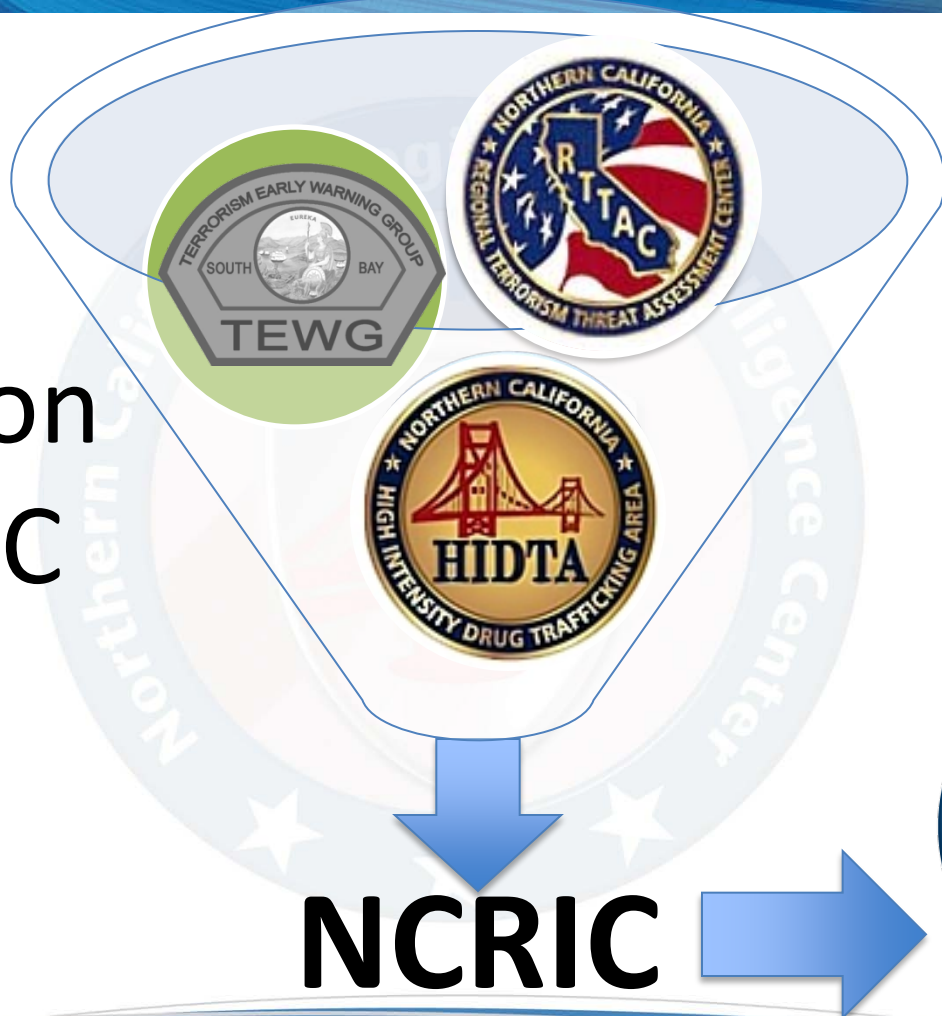

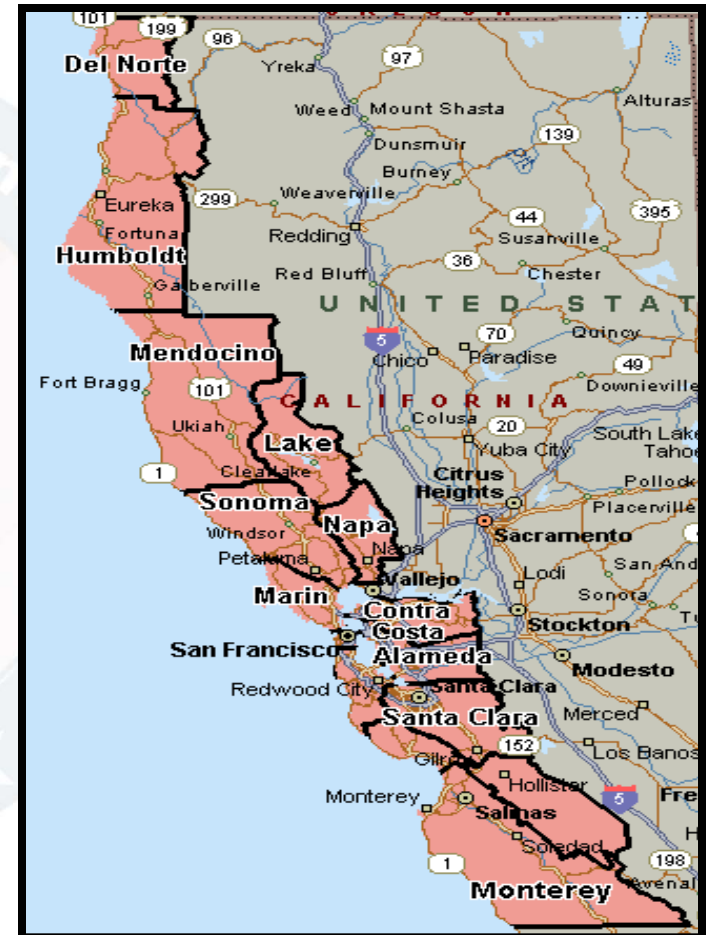

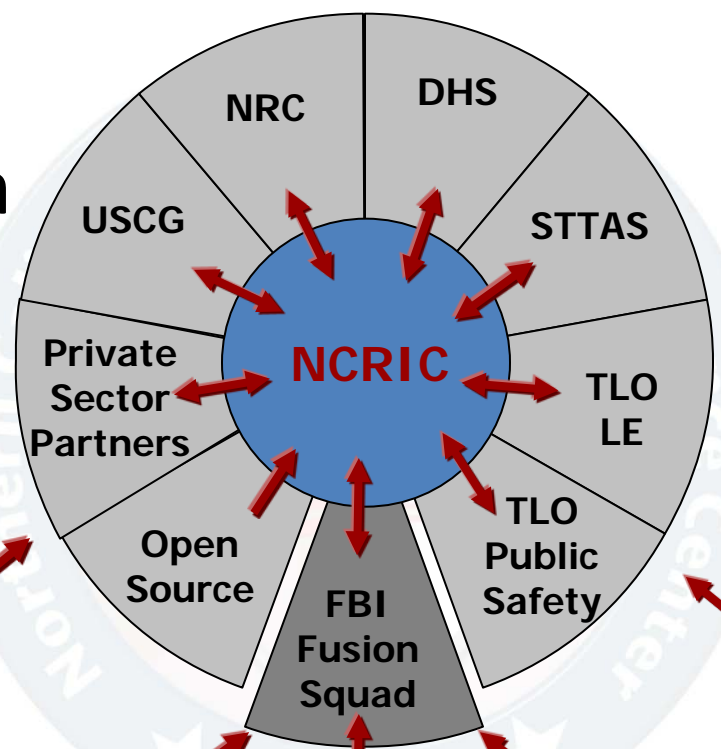

NCRIC Threat Analysis

NCRIC provides analysis based on:

- Special Events (e.g. Fleet Week)
- Analyst-observed threat/activity trends
- Leads or requests from private sector and law enforcement partners

- Your Public Safety Agency's Bulletins and BOLO's can be sent through the www.ncric.org web system. E-mail your dissemination requests to dutyofficer@ncric.org.
- The NCRIC's Roam Secure Alert Network (RSAN)
 - Available to Your Agency to provide immediate threat/status information.
 - Capable of transmitting 18,000 text messages/minute to key NCRIC members' portable electronic devices and e-mail
