The Brady Handgun Violence Prevention Act of 1993 (Brady Act) is the Result of . . .


- Permanent injuries sustained by Press Secretary James Brady during the attempted assassination of former President Ronald Reagan
- The Brady's lobbied for stricter regulations in relation to the transfer of firearms
- The Brady Act was signed into law on November 30, 1993

ICE databases are searched to obtain the current immigration status with all transactions initiated for non-U.S. citizens.





Access to the NICS




Disposition of Firearms

- Criminal justice agencies may now access the NICS to conduct a background check to dispose of a firearm in their inventory
- The check is allowed by law, not required, before the firearm is disposed/returned
- By law, NICS is not accessible to criminal justice agencies for investigative purposes



Law Enforcement Enterprise Portal (LEEP)

Individuals or agencies with LEEP or LEO access can continue to access LEEP or LEO via their existing methods. To apply for LEEP access, sign onto <www.cjis.gov> and "Apply for an account". When an individual/agency is properly enrolled, they may access the LEEP resources through the following path:

- Log onto <www.cjis.gov>
- Under SERVICES, select LEO Special Interest Group (SIG), then click "OK" to "Message from webpage" (*at this point, you may select "NICS" under "MY SIGS" IF "Add to My SIGs" was previously accessed—see note below.)
- Select "Browse SIGs", then "OK"
- Select "By Access Type"
- Select "Unrestricted," then "OK"
- Select the icon labeled "NICS"
- Now you should be at NICS homepage. Please review the information listed under "STATE/FEDERAL REFERENCE MATERIAL" for terminology pages, state information pages, state prohibitions, pardon and restoration information, Interface Control, and much more.

*Note: On the NICS homepage there is a link titled "Add to My SIGs"—accessing this allows the user to create a "shortcut" to the NICS homepage.
