RECENT DEVELOPMENTS

U.S. CENTRAL COMMAND:

AFGHANISTAN – 37 RCIEDs Found and Cleared in Various Provinces

On 14 June, in Ghor, Jowzjan, Baghlan, and Kunduz provinces, ANSF found and cleared 37 RCIEDs and other materials of war during a series of clearing operations. Additionally, ANSF killed 30 insurgents, wounded another 37, and detained 27 more during these operations.¹

AFGHANISTAN – Explosives Found and Cleared in Manogai

On 14 June, in Lechama village, Manogai (aka Darah ye Pech) district, Kunar province, the Afghan National Army (ANA) found and cleared a depot of unknown explosive material hidden in a cave.²

AFGHANISTAN – Haqqani Terrorist Detained in Mohammad Agha

On 14 June, in Mohammad Agha district, Logar province, National Directorate of Security (NDS) forces detained a key member of the Haqqani terrorist network who was a skilled IED manufacturer, identified as Sardar, in possession of 80kg of explosives, two rifles with four (4) magazines, and 400 rounds of ammunition.³ (See figure 1)

AFGHANISTAN – 21 IEDs Found and Cleared in Maiwand

On 13 June, in Maiwand district, Kandahar province, Afghan National Security Forces (ANSF) found and cleared 21 unknown IEDs (10 barrel mines and 11 various mines), a

sack of explosives, and other materials of war during cleansing operation Ghalib. Additionally, six (6) insurgents, including their commander, Mullah Jabbar, were killed during this operation.⁴

EGYPT – IED Found and Cleared in Arish

On 14 June, in Nafora district, Arish, North Sinai governorate, explosive experts found and cleared an unknown roadside IED.⁵

IRAQ – IED Killed One, Wounded Seven in Shaikh Omar

On 14 June, in Shaikh Omar, central Baghdad, an unknown IED detonated, killing one (1) civilian and wounding seven (7) others.⁶

IRAQ – IED Wounded Three Soldiers in Arab Jabour

On 14 June, in Arab Jabour, Dora district, southern Baghdad, an unknown roadside IED detonated as an army patrol passed by, wounding three (3) soldiers.⁷

IRAQ – IED Killed Two, Wounded Six in Shaab South

On 14 June, in Shaab South, Adamiyah district, northeastern Baghdad, an unknown roadside IED detonated near the Shalal Pazar (waterfall market), killing two (2) civilians and wounding six (6) others.⁸

IRAQ – IED Killed One, Wounded Four in Al Amin

On 14 June, in al Amin, eastern Baghdad, an unknown roadside IED detonated, killing one (1) civilian and wounding four (4) others.⁹

IRAQ – Six PBIEDs, Seven VBIEDs Interdicted in Fallujah

On 14 June, in southern Fallujah, federal police forces interdicted/killed six (6) Islamic State of Iraq and Syria (ISIS) PBIEDs, destroyed seven (7) VBIEDs and killed 30 militants.¹⁰

IRAQ – Four VBIEDs Found and Cleared in Fallujah

On 14 June, in al Jaffa and al Asriyah, western Fallujah, al Anbar province, joint security forces found and cleared four (4) VBIEDs and killed 16 ISIS militants during a liberation operation.¹¹

IRAQ – IED Killed Two, Wounded Nine in Karadah

On 14 June, in al Wehda, Karadah district, central Baghdad, an unknown IED detonated near a popular market, killing two (2) civilians and wounding nine (9) others.¹²

IRAQ – IED Killed Two, Wounded Five in Baghdad

On 14 June, in eastern Baghdad, an unknown roadside IED detonated near a civil generator, killing two (2) engineers and wounding five (5) civilian bystanders.¹³

PAKISTAN – Two IEDs/Explosives Found and Cleared in Quetta

On 14 June, in Quetta city, capital of Balochistan province, police launched a search operation for militants associated with Tehreek i Taliban Pakistan (TTP) who opened fire. Police killed five (5) militants and then found and cleared 15kg of unknown explosives, two (2) unknown IEDs (hand-made bombs) and other war materials in their hideout.¹⁴

SYRIA – Regime Helicopters Dropped Barrel Bombs

On 14 June, in Daraya city, Rif Dimashq province, Syrian regime helicopters dropped at least eight (8) barrel bombs, with no casualties reported.¹⁵

U.S. SOUTHERN COMMAND:

COLOMBIA – Timer IED Found and Cleared in Patia

On 14 June, in Puente Fierro village, Patia municipality, Cauca department, soldiers found and cleared a timer IED (timer activation system).¹⁶

COLOMBIA – IEDs Found and Cleared in Tumaco

On 14 June, in Tumaco municipality, Narino department, soldiers found and cleared six (6) unknown IEDs (landmines) found in plastic containers with detonators, slow fuse, shrapnel and composite of a substance with similar characteristics to ammonium nitrate and an unknown IED comprised of approximately 350 grams of explosive hidden inside a cacao plantation, 60 meters from a petrol filling station, property of the Ejercito de Liberacion Nacional (ELN) Elder Santos Company.¹⁷ (See figure 2)

U.S. NORTHERN COMMAND:

UNITED STATES (FL) – Four IEDs Detonated in Hillsborough (Source link removed)

On 14 June, at Monterey Lakeside Park in Hillsborough county, police detained a 30-yr old man (later bonded out) after showing a 10-yr old boy how to set off four (4) unknown IEDs (acid bombs). More bomb-making chemicals were found in the suspect's car.¹⁸

OTHER IMPROVISED THREATS:

NIGERIA – NDA's Demands for Government Talks

On 13 June, the Niger Delta Avengers (NDA) agreed to dialogue with the government under certain conditions, to include no repair of damaged infrastructure during talks, and independent mediators to be appointed. Also, NDA threatened to sink oil firm vessels if operations continued.¹⁹
