RECENT DEVELOPMENTS

U.S. CENTRAL COMMAND:

AFGHANISTAN – IED Killed MP Member in Kabul

On 6 June, in the 5th police district, Kabul city, an unknown IED emplaced in an electricity box detonated, killing one (1) civilian, Member of Parliament (MP) Sher Wali Wardak, brother of Farooq Wardak (former Minister of Education). No group has claimed responsibility.¹ (See figure 1)

EGYPT – 11 IEDs Found and Cleared in Giza

On 7 June, in Badrasheen, Giza governorate, security forces found and cleared a cache containing about 11 unknown IEDs.²

EGYPT – IED Killed One Soldier in Sheikh Zuweid

On 7 June, in Sheikh Zuweid, North Sinai governorate, an unknown IED targeting a checkpoint detonated, killing one (1) soldier.³

IRAQ – 3 PBIEDs Interdicted, 1 PBIED Killed Two in Haditha

On 7 June, in Haditha, al Anbar province, security forces engaged four (4) PBIEDs at the Haditha Asphalt Factory.

Security forces interdicted three (3) PBIEDs while the 4th PBIED detonated, killing two (2) civilians.⁴

IRAQ – IEDs Killed Five Civilians in Mosul

On 7 June, in Khazer, northern Mosul, Ninawa province, an undisclosed number of unknown IEDs, left by Islamic State of Iraq and Syria (ISIS) members, detonated in civilian homes, killing five (5) displaced civilians.⁵

IRAQ – IED Killed One, Wounded Five in Al Nahrawan

On 7 June, in al Nahrawan, southeastern Baghdad province, an unknown IED detonated near shops, killing one (1) civilian and wounding five (5) others.⁶

IRAQ – VBIED Killed Three, Wounded 35 in Al Hussain District

On 7 June, in al Hussain District, Karbala city, capital of Karbala province, a VBIED detonated, killing three (3) civilians and wounding 35 others.⁷

IRAQ – IED Killed Two, Wounded Six in Fudhaliyah

On 7 June, in Fudhaliyah, eastern Baghdad, an unknown roadside IED detonated near shops, killing two (2) civilians and wounding six (6) others.⁸

IRAQ – IED Killed One, Wounded Six in Shaab South

On 7 June, in Shaab South, Adhamiyah district, northeastern Baghdad, an unknown roadside IED detonated near Shalal Pazar (waterfall market), killing one (1) civilian and wounding six (6) others.⁹

IRAQ – IED Wounded Four in Jisr Diyala

On 7 June, in Jisr Diyala, southeastern Baghdad province, an unknown roadside IED detonated, wounding four (4) civilians.¹⁰

IRAQ – VBIED/Booby-Trapped Houses/IEDs Found and Cleared in Baghdad

On 6 June, in western Baghdad province, Baghdad Operations forces found and cleared one (1) VBIED, 108 booby-trapped houses, and 262 unknown IEDs. Additionally, forces killed 148 terrorists and wounded 67 others.¹¹

On 7 June, in Istanbul, an RC-VBIED targeting a police bus detonated near the main tourist district, a major university and the mayor’s office, killing 11 people and wounding 36 more. No group has claimed responsibility.¹² (See figure 2)

U.S. PACIFIC COMMAND:

[PHILIPPINES – IED Wounded Four in Datu Unsay](#)

On 7 June, in Meta village, Datu Unsay town, Maguindanao province, an unknown IED detonated on a military foot patrol, wounding four (4) soldiers. While the group responsible is unknown, the Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF) and its breakaway Bangsamoro Islamic Freedom Fighters (BIFF) operate in the area.¹³

U.S. SOUTHERN COMMAND:

[COLOMBIA – Two IEDs Found and Cleared in Tibu](#)

On 7 June, in La Gabarra, Tibu municipality, Norte de Santander department, soldiers found and cleared two (2) unknown IEDs, property of the Ejercito de Liberacion Nacional (ELN) Luis Enrique Leon Front.¹⁴

OTHER IMPROVISED THREATS:

[IRAQ – ISIS to Combine Chemical Weapons and Suicide Bombings](#)

On 7 June, Peshmerga General Akram Mohammed Abdulrahman said “while ISIS has previously used both chemical weapons and suicide bombings separately, they are now looking to combine them. ISIS’s tactic involves training brainwashed teenage insurgents to carry out suicide bombing using munitions containing harmful chemicals.”¹⁵
