(U//LES) Peace in Ukraine: 18 March 2023

(U) Scope

(U//LES) Please see below city-by-city breakdown of what is planned (to date) for the remainder of the week, into the following week and beyond. This list may not reflect the full list of planned protests, as many of them are being set up by word of mouth within a few hours.

(U//FOUO) The New Mexico All Source Intelligence Center (NMASIC) recognizes individuals have constitutionally protected rights to assemble, speak and petition the government. The NMASIC safeguards these rights and only reports on First Amendment-protected activities for operational planning in the interest of public safety.

(U) Synopsis

Peace In Ukraine protest is scheduled to take place March 18, 2023 at San Mateo and Gibson in Albuquerque at 1400 hrs.. This protest is hosted by the Party for Socialism and Liberation. There are no known numbers at this time, however based on historical events with PSL, they tend to have 50-150 people show up depending on the cause.
