### China -- PRC Military Commentators' Blogs

This report surveys 10 prominent PRC commentators on military affairs who appear to write blogs hosted on PRC and PRC-owned Hong Kong websites. All of these commentators appear to maintain an online presence using these blogs to promote their viewpoints. Commentators cover such topics as PRC military strategy, air defense, navy issues, army aviation, information technology, defense spending, foreign military developments, military-to-military relations, political education, military history, training, and exercises. These blogs appear on China's authoritative government websites, popular PRC commercial portal sites, and independent Hong Kong news websites.

#### **Source Note**

The military commentators discussed in this report have been selected based on one or more of the following factors: observed frequency of television appearances, number of articles written, position in top military academies, fields of study, and areas of expertise. Commentators are listed alphabetically. Blog order is based on view count. OSC is generally unable to verify the identity or location of posters or readers of these online blogs. Furthermore, OSC is unable to verify the extent of censorship or manipulation of online discussion. Statistical information has been provided, when available, directly from the respective blogs and may be false or incorrect. All data is current as of 10 June 2010.

#### Dai Xu 戴旭



Military Strategist Dai Xu (Xinhua)

Dai Xu is a PLA Air Force colonel and columnist for *Huanqiu Shibao* -- a newspaper sponsored by party daily *Renmin Ribao* -- that focuses on international issues and foreign reaction to developments in the PRC. He appears to maintain blogs at People.com.cn, Caogen.com, Sina.com, China.com.cn, and Huanqiu.com.

Dai writes on a broad range of topics in popular and specialized military media and has been cited as an "Air Force strategist" in *Huanqiu Shibao* (20 August 2009). He has advocated building the PRC into a maritime power to protect its overseas interests and has called for increasing the PRC's ability to develop "strategic industries" related to national defense. Dai appears to be a critic of US efforts to achieve "space hegemony" and of what he portrays as Japanese militarism (29 March 2007, 27 February 2007).

Dai recently generated a minor controversy among Chinese military enthusiasts and others when he warned in *Guoji Zhanwang* -- a now defunct semimonthly journal published by the Shanghai Institute of International Studies -- that the debut of the US fighter F-22A gave the United States an even stronger asymmetrical advantage in conventional warfighting (15 October 2006).<sup>4 5</sup>

## Jin Yinan 金一南



PRC Military Expert Jin Yinan (Renmin Wang)

A renowned expert in the Strategy, Teaching, and Research Department at the National Defense University (NDU) -- a premier military academy in China -- Jin Yinan has been hailed in the Central Military Commission (CMC) daily *Jiefangjun Bao* as an example of someone who overcame adversity and limited formal education to become one of the PLA's "great teachers" (11 September 2007, 20 January 2006). He appears to maintain blogs at People.com.cn and Voc.com.cn.

Jin specializes in analyzing how technology, especially information technology, has transformed the nature of war, and he provides commentary on world military developments. Jin has argued that Asians' armies possess a uniquely "Asian" fighting spirit that makes them especially tenacious and fearless, according to *Jiefangjun Bao* (2 June 2006).

# Luo Yuan 罗援



Major General Luo Yuan (Xinhua)

Major General Luo Yuan serves as the deputy director of the World Military Affairs Research Department at the Academy of Military Science (AMS) -- a premier PRC military institution. He appears to maintain blogs at Sina.com and Blshe.com.

Luo has declared that the United States "will pay an unbearable price" if it is involved in a war with China over Taiwan and has stated that the United States will "not go to war with a nuclear power" over Taiwan, according to a newspaper sponsored by *Renmin Ribao* (*Huanqiu Shibao*, 20 December 2004). His denunciations of then Taiwan President Chen Shuibian have been carried by China's official news agency Xinhua (10 March 2004; 18 November 2004). Uno occasionally appears on television programs such as CCTV-7's "Defense Review Week [Fangwu Xin Guancha 防务新观察]" as a commentator (18 February 2007; 8 February 2009).

# Ma Dingsheng 马鼎盛



Military Commentator Ma Dingsheng (Sina.com, 22 October 2006)

Described by Phoenix TV as it's "Hong Kong-based military commentator" and expert on cross-Strait issues and China's arms development, Ma was born in Hong Kong and raised in mainland China (23 April 2008). He appears to maintain blogs at Ifeng.com, Sina.com, Caogen.com, and Sohu.com.

After graduating from Sun Yat-sen University in Guangzhou with a degree in history, Ma worked at the History Institute of the Guangdong Provincial Academy of Social Sciences from 1982 to 1989. He then emigrated from the mainland to Hong Kong, where he worked as an editor at the PRC-owned Hong Kong papers *Ta Kung Pao* and *Wen Wei Po*, as well as at the independent Hong Kong media organizations Ming Pao, Tin Tin Jih Pao, Sing Tao Jih Pao, Ping Kuo Jih Pao, and Radio Television Hong Kong. Ma joined Phoenix TV in 2003. <sup>16</sup>

# Qiao Liang 乔良



Colonel Qiao Liang (Xinhua)

PLA Air Force Colonel Qiao Liang is a professor in the Strategic Studies Department of the Air Force Command College, according to a monthly journal of the State Council's Chinese Institute of Contemporary International Relations (20 May 2008). He appears to maintain a blog at Sina.com.

Known for his co-authorship of *Unrestricted Warfare* [*Chao Xian Zhan* 超限战] with Wang Xiangsui, Qiao's articles view the West with deep suspicion. Following the 2008 Tibet riots, he argued that the world was headed toward a "soft war" along the lines of a clash between Western and Chinese cultural values in the coming decades, according to *Xiandai Guoji Guanxi* (20 May 2008). 19

# Song Xiaojun 宋晓军



Military Expert Song Xiaojun (CCTV-4, 29May 2009)

Song Xiaojun is a Beijing-based military expert who appears to comment regularly on PRC aviation issues. He is chief editor of the magazine *Jianchuan Zhishi* [Naval and Merchant Ships 舰船知识] and and a former sonar and radar specialist in the PLA Navy. Song is also known for his knowledge of Taiwan, maritime disputes in the South China Sea, and his commentary on the war in Iraq (CCTV, 1 February, 12 January, 21 June 2009; Phoenix TV, 11 December 2009). Phoenix TV, 11 December 2009). He appears to maintain blogs at Sina.com, People.com.cn, and Caogen.com.

Song is co-author of *Zhongguo Bu Gaoxing* [*Unhappy China*中国不高兴], a book that argues the PRC should "come to recognize the fact that it has the power to lead the world, and the necessity to break away from Western influence" (Xinhua, 25 March 2009).<sup>24</sup>

# Teng Jianqun 滕建群



Military Commentator Teng Jianqun (Renmin Wang)

A research fellow at the China Arms Control and Disarmament Association and columnist at Party Daily *Renmin Ribao*, Teng is a prolific writer who routinely defends Chinese defense policy against charges of lack of transparency. Teng also writes on arms control, space militarization, and US-China relations. Teng reportedly served in the PLA Navy for 10 years, serving in both the South Sea and North Sea Fleets, and worked at the AMS for 10 years (*Renmin Wang*, 30 March 2005). He appears to maintain blogs at People.com.cn and Sina.com.

A supporter of space technology, Teng drew criticism from Chinese bloggers when he wrote an article arguing that China should focus on acquiring space technology rather than develop an aircraft carrier, according to the official website of *Renmin Ribao* (22 November 2005).<sup>26</sup>

# Wang Xiangsui 王湘穗



Military Commentator Wang Xiangsui (Sina.com)

Director of the Strategy Center at the Beijing University of Aeronautics and Astronautics, Wang gained fame as the co-author of the book *Unrestricted Warfare* [Chao Xian Zhan 超限战] with Qiao Liang. Prior to his academic career, Wang served as a political commissar in the PLA and is the author of several books on military history and military analysis (*Guoji Zhanwang*, 1 November 2005; Phoenix TV, 18 April 2007). He appears to maintain a blog at People.com.cn.

Wang provides commentary and analysis for non-PRC-owned media, such as the Singapore newspaper *Straits Times* and Phoenix TV's "Observation Post of Military Situation." In these venues, Wang has occasionally disagreed with decisions by the Chinese leadership, such as when he questioned the wisdom of building an aircraft carrier (10 January 2007, 24 December 2008).<sup>29 30</sup>

### Yao Youzhi 姚有志



Military Expert Yao Youzhi (Renmin Wang)

Director of war theories and strategic studies at the AMS, Yao also sits on the editorial board of the magazine *CONMILIT* [Xiandai Junshi 现代军事] -- a PRC monthly journal covering international and Chinese military affairs. He appears to maintain a blog at People.com.cn.

Yao often provides commentary in PRC media on foreign military developments and the importance of the PLA's human capital (*Jiefangjun Bao*, 22 March 2007; *Ta Kung Pao*, 9 June 2006). Ta Known for his blunt, outspoken style, Yao has expressed especially hawkish views on Japan. He has, for example, accused Tokyo of "covertly fomenting Taiwan independence," according to PRC-owned daily newspaper *Ta Kung Pao* (9 June 2006). Yao is also a noted military strategist, having edited the book *Science of Military Strategy* with Peng Guanggian (26 January 2007).

# Zhang Zhaozhong 张召忠



Military Expert Zhang Zhaozhong (sogou.com)

PLA Navy Rear Admiral Zhang is the director of the National Defense University Military Logistics and Equipment Department. Zhang appears to be one of China's most well-known television commentators on military topics. His reputation briefly suffered when he predicted immediate US defeat against a "People's War"-inspired Iraqi resistance (*Renmin Wang*, 18 April 2003). When his predictions proved erroneous, CCTV dropped him as a military analyst in 2003. However, in 2006, he became the host of the CCTV-7 program "Defense Review Week." He appears to maintain blogs at People.com.cn, Ifeng.com, and Huanqiu.com.

Zhang has expressed support for the idea of China's adopting a "preemptive strike" strategy (CCTV-7, 27 August 2006). He studied at the UK's Royal Military College of Science in 2001.
