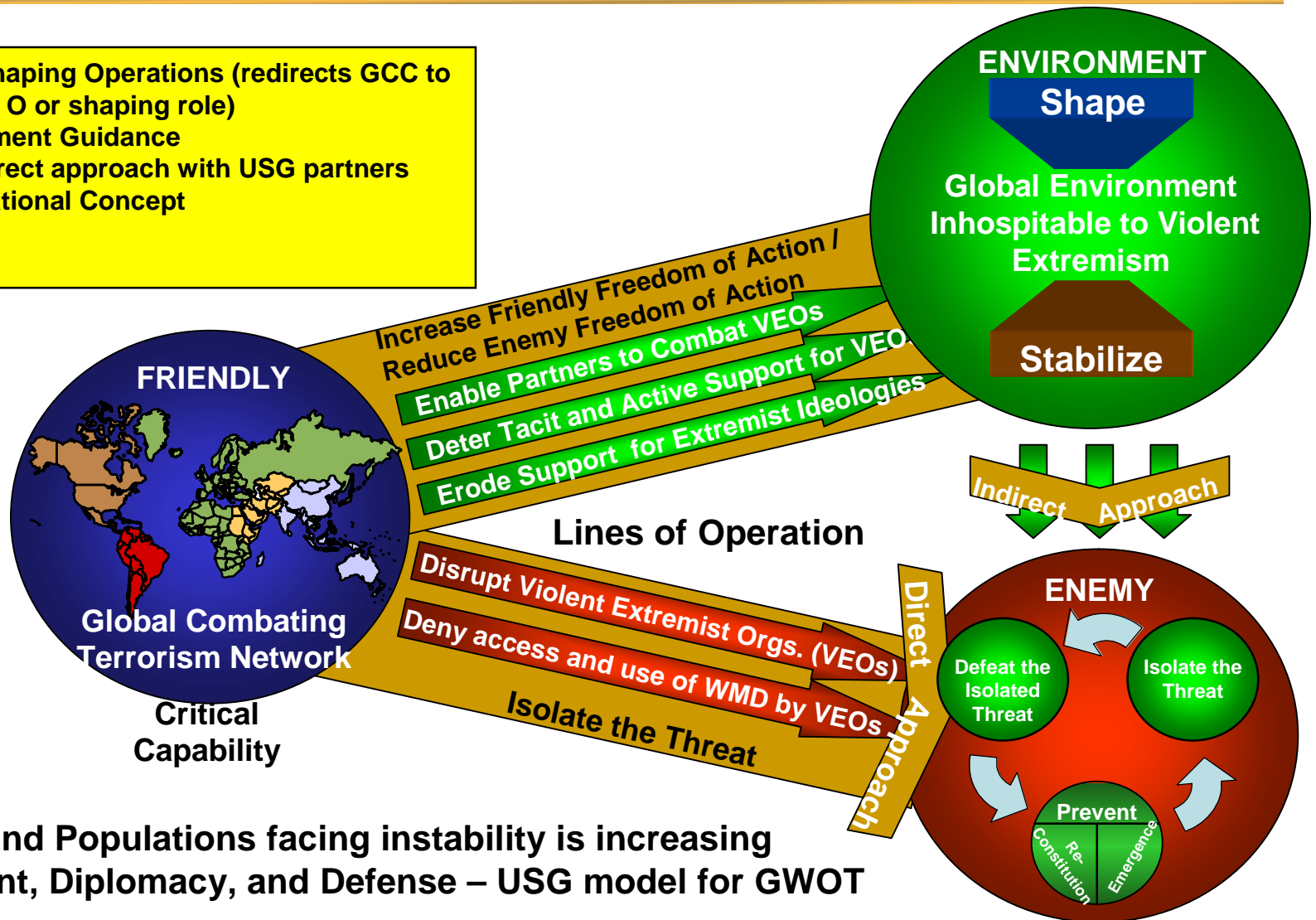

- Development, Diplomacy, and Defense – USG model for GWOT

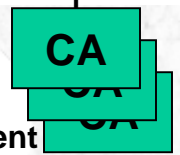


SOF CA Demand Signal

- Iraq, Afghanistan, Philippines – on-going

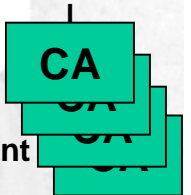

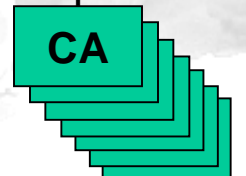

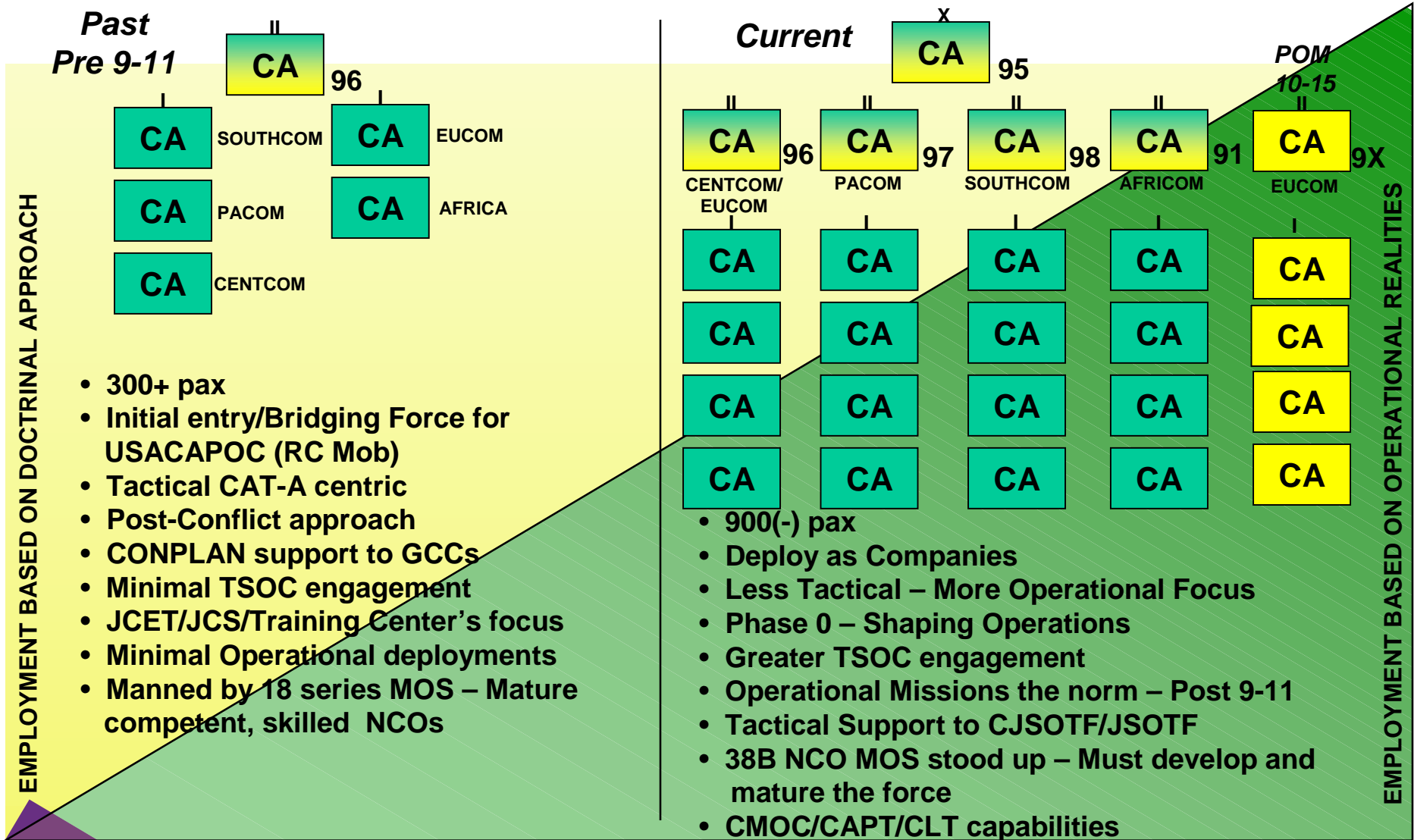
BDE 1:0.8 Dwell Ratio

Build complete 3rd Qtr FY09



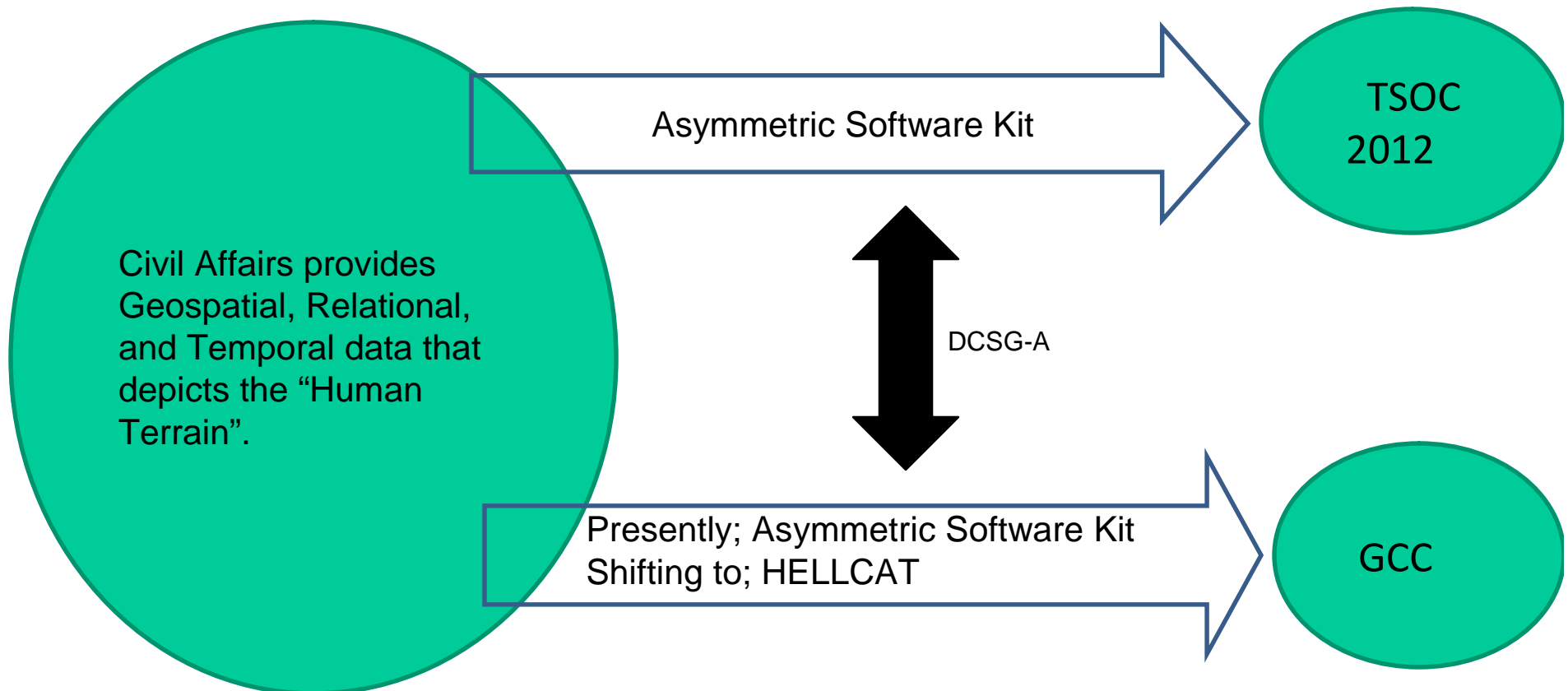


AC CA Growth





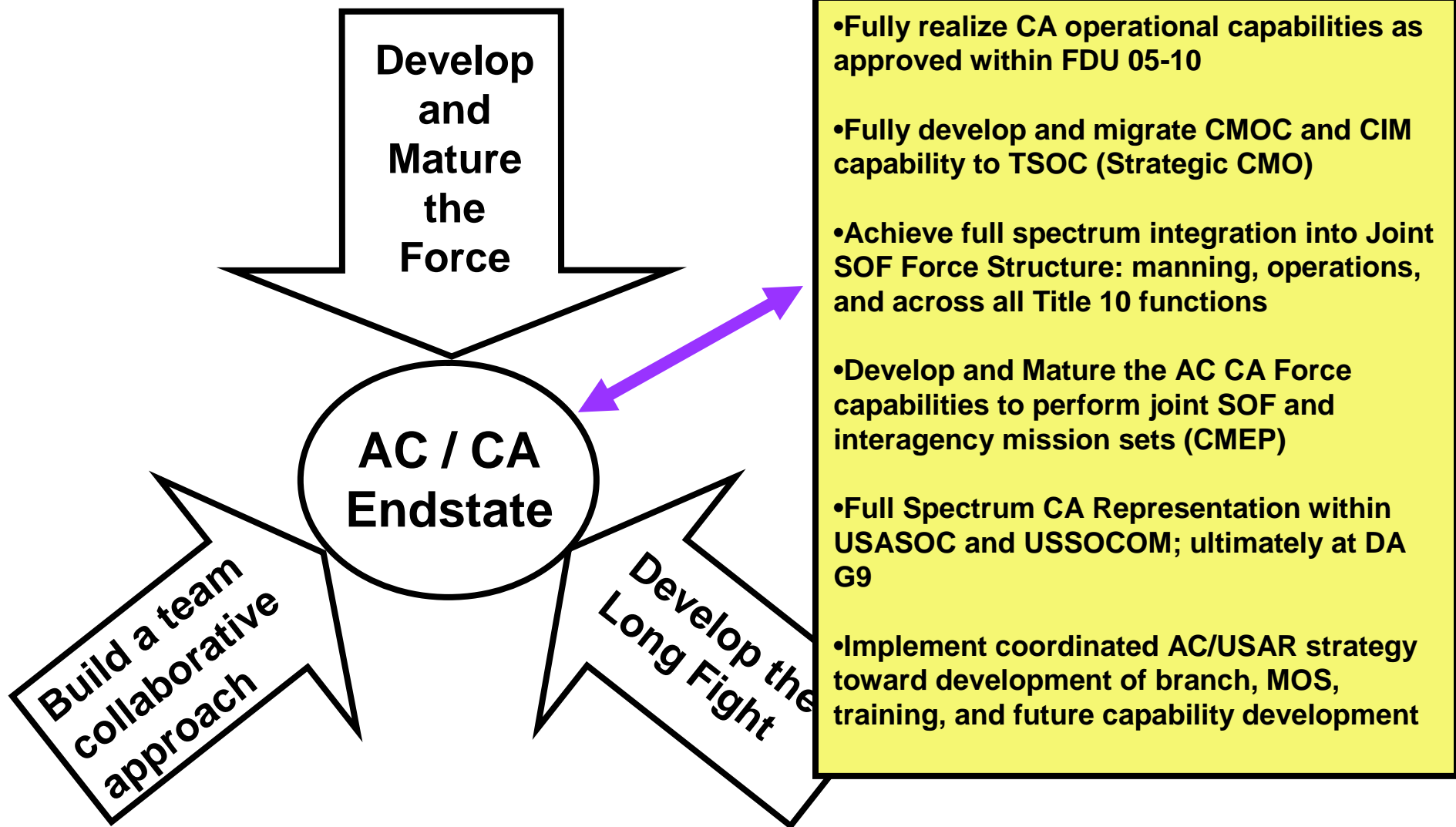
Civil Information Management SITREP

Things To Think About

- Inform the Critical Task Review Board
- Focus Effort in support of JCIM: cooperative approach
- Advocate for Army G9
- Make a more of a CA capital investment into SWC and CAG-Leavenworth (stability operations)
- Use ongoing studies to develop a strategic CA Way Ahead--5 to 10 years focus, 3-5 year execution
- Address the missing middle
- Leverage CA Functional Expertise
 - Direct commissioning, bonuses
 - Enables USG stability efforts,
 - Academic Partnerships
 - Integrate Private Sector
