
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

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


SOF CA Demand Signal






AC CA Growth



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95TH CDR's Way Ahead



•Fully realize CA operational capabilities as approved within FDU 05-10

•Fully develop and migrate CMOC and CIM capability to TSOC (Strategic CMO)

•Achieve full spectrum integration into Joint SOF Force Structure: manning, operations, and across all Title 10 functions

•Develop and Mature the AC CA Force capabilities to perform joint SOF and interagency mission sets (CMEP)

•Full Spectrum CA Representation within USASOC and USSOCOM; ultimately at DA G9

•Implement coordinated AC/USAR strategy toward development of branch, MOS, training, and future capability development

- Make a more of a CA capital investment into SWC and CAG-Leavenworth (stability operations)
