


## 2009 Democratic People's Republic of Korea Leadership Chart\*

\*The structure of this chart is primarily taken from a reference pamphlet published by the South Korean Ministry of Unification in January 2009, which appears to be based on the DPRK constitution. As such, this chart is a representation of the formal relationships between the various entities and does not necessarily reflect the actual hierarchy and power relationships in the North Korean system. Other sources include: DPRK, ROK, PRC, and Japanese media; the ROK National Intelligence Service website; the Ministry of Unification's Key Figures of North Korea 2009; and Japan's Radiopress North Korea Directory 2008. Marriage/Liaison DATES: The date listed below each name denotes the earliest the person was known to have filled the post, as reported by open sources. Where possible, names and offices are in the order in which they appear Blood Relation HIGHLIGHTS: Individuals highlighted with red borders are those who have neither appeared in nor been mentioned by name in North Korean media throughout 2008.
